**DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC – ANNUAL REVIEW OF
BASE RATES FOR FUEL COSTS**

S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-865 (Supp. 2010) established a procedure for annual hearings to allow the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“the Commission”) and all interested parties to review the fuel purchasing practices and policies of the Company and for the Commission to determine if any adjustment in the fuel cost recovery mechanism is necessary and reasonable.

In order for testimony and evidence to be received from all interested parties, a public hearing will be held in the Commission’s Hearing Room, Synergy Business Park, Saluda Building, 101 Executive Center Drive, Columbia, S.C. on **Thursday, August 25, 2011 at 10:30 a.m.**
