



## Duke Energy Ohio Low Income Gas Rate Pilot Program Application Form

### To Qualify:

To receive a \$4 monthly discount on your natural gas bill you must:

- Be a Duke Energy gas customer, and use less than 900 ccf annually. (You can find annual usage on your bill.)
- Not be on the Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP).
- Have income at or below 175% of the poverty level.
