Be Aware of Power Lines

TIPS TO HELP YOU STAY SAFE AROUND POWER LINES.

- Report downed or sagging power lines to Duke Energy immediately. Do not touch the line or anything that is in contact with the line. Always assume a downed line is energized and dangerous.
- Do not attempt to cut limbs or trees that are growing near overhead power lines, call Duke Energy for assistance.

- Never climb utility poles, transmission towers or substation fences.
- Keep ladders and other equipment at least 10 feet away from all overhead power lines, including any lines from the power pole to your home.
- Fly kites, model planes and other toys in open areas away from power lines, using nonmetallic strings or cords.
- Do not try to remove any object caught in power lines. Call Duke Energy for safe removal.
- Look up for power lines before making roof repairs, installing antennas and satellite dishes, or using other long tools. Metals and wet objects conduct electricity.
