### South Carolina Appliance Rebates

Beginning March 31, 2010, rebates of \$50 to \$500 are available to South Carolina residents who purchase qualifying ENERGY STAR® appliances to replace older, less-efficient appliances. Act fast. Rebates will end when the program's funds are exhausted.
