1	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin customer outreach • Reduce withdrawals from Lake Keowee (Goal = 3 to 5% or more below amount otherwise expected) 	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request voluntary water use restrictions by lake neighbors irrigating lawns (≤ 2 days per week irrigation)
2	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emphasize water conservation needs in customer outreach • Further reduce withdrawals from Lake Keowee (Goal = 5 to 10% or more below amount otherwise expected) 	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift conference calls to bi-weekly • Require mandatory water use restrictions by lake neighbors irrigating lawns (≤ 2 days per week irrigation)
3	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emphasize water conservation needs in customer outreach • Further reduce withdrawals from Lake Keowee (Goal = 10 to 20% or more below amount otherwise expected) 	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold bi-weekly conference calls • Reduce or eliminate Keowee flow releases • Require mandatory water use restrictions by lake neighbors irrigating lawns (≤ 1 day per week irrigation)
4	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emphasize water conservation needs in customer outreach • Further reduce withdrawals from Lake Keowee (Goal = 20 to 30% or more below amount otherwise expected) 	Stage 0 Actions plus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold bi-weekly (or more frequently if needed) conference calls • Reduce or eliminate Keowee flow releases • Require lake neighbors irrigating lawns to stop all irrigation from lake pumps
