

LAKE KEOWEE SURVEILLANCE CONTRACTOR PROCESS

Duke Energy Lake Services has contracted an individual, through Scope Services, who will inspect the shoreline of the Lake Keowee by boat as directed by Duke Energy Lake Services for the purpose of identifying any violations of the Company's Shoreline Management Programs, encroachments or any other potential property issue with Duke Energy. Guidelines for construction of activities within the Project Boundaries are outlined in the Duke Energy Shoreline Management Guidelines.

The contractor will inspect the Project Boundaries of Lake Keowee as assigned by Duke Energy Lake Services and will schedule his/her work in accordance with specific requirements of Lake Services. The contractor will provide a boat, trailer and tow vehicle, fuel, camera, telephone and any other equipment and maintenance thereof, for performing the surveillance duties, unless otherwise specified.

The contractor will, in addition to visual inspection, provide photos to the Lake Service Representative(s), distribute warning notices and other general information if required. The contractor will not have the authority to approve or disapprove any lake use permitting issue while performing his/her duties. The contractor will only report the status of any violation or encroachment to Lake Services for final determination and disposition.

The contractor will report any violations of the Lake Keowee Shoreline Management Plan or Shoreline Management Guidelines within one working day to the Lake Keowee Service Representative(s).
