DukeNet Communication Services Announces Completion of Three New Tower Sites In Southern Indiana – More in Construction

DukeNet Communication Services, LLC (“DNCS”) today announces completion of construction of 3 new tower sites in south-central Indiana. The sites are:

- Whitfield, Martin County, IN (N38-37-41, W086-54-56, 250’ AGL)
- Williams, Lawrence County, IN (N38-49-38, W86-38-51, 250’ AGL)
- French Lick, Orange County, IN (N38-33-07, W86-36-13, 250’ AGL)

Duke Energy Indiana (“Duke”) is the anchor tenant for these sites and will be installing Omni and microwave antennas for its proprietary iDEN communication system.

All of these sites are 250’ self-support towers. DNCS builds towers only to the latest (EIA/TIA 222-G) engineering standards with ample capacity for additional carrier collocations.

In addition to the three initial tower sites, DNCS and Duke have signed definitive agreements for three additional tower sites in Southern Indiana. The three additional sites are in various stages of development with construction of all sites expected to be completed in no later than November, 2007. The three additional sites are:

- Wilmington, Dearborn County, IN(N39-03-46, W84-59-08, 250’ AGL)
- Shoals, Martin County, IN (N38-39-45, W86-45-04, 180’ AGL)
- Paoli, Orange County, IN (N38-34-17, W86-27-42, 250’ AGL)

“The development of these tower sites illustrates the cooperative spirit between DNCS and Duke” said Dan Turnpaugh, DNCS Director of Tower Operations. “Five of the six sites are developed on Duke Energy real estate under development rights agreements we have with Duke and all of the tower leases were negotiated under the Master Facilities Lease Agreement between Duke and DNCS. With the agreements we have in place, we feel that these sites are simply tip of the iceberg.”
