- Paoli, Orange County, IN (N38-34-17, W86-27-42)

Duke Energy Indiana is the anchor tenant for the three sites. Duke will be using the sites for its enhanced emergency first responder radio network. Following the completion of the three sites, DNCS has constructed a total of six sites for Duke Energy Indiana in 2007.

In addition to the sites built in 2007, DNCS and Duke Energy have signed definitive agreements for two additional tower sites in the Cincinnati market. Construction of the two new sites will be completed by the end of April 2008. The two additional sites are:

- Summerside, Clermont County, OH (N39-07-04, W84-17-22)
- Warsaw, Gallatin County, KY (N38-45-57, W84-53-46)
